Here is a list of recent accomplishments and upcoming tasks to date:

## Since the last report:

- Drywall taping and sanding has been completed except for touch up
- Painting has begun in the multi-purpose/lobby area
- Installing ceiling grid in multi-purpose/lobby area
- Rooftop units are running in the classroom wings
- Windows and exterior doors installed
- Poured sidewalks
- Installing Ceramic tile in restrooms
- Installing Vinyl tile flooring

- Complete painting
- Wire for phone and data lines
- Install ceiling tile
- Begin carpet install
- Install interior doors and hardware
- Finish mechanical and electrical trim outs
- Install handrail at sidewalk

One question we have received recently is regarding the elevation at the new Hanson Entrance. The floor elevation in the addition is set to match the floor elevation in the existing building which is considerably higher than the parking lot elevation along Hanson Boulevard. In order to keep from losing any parking spaces or incurring the cost of raising and repaving the parking lot, the entrance was designed with a sloped sidewalk and steps to accommodate the difference in elevation. As a safety precaution, a handrail/guardrail will be installed along the raised sidewalk edge to protect the general public and users of the facility from inadvertently stumbling over the edge.
